SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Investment, Trade and Industry by section 42 (1) as read with section 42 (2) (a) of the Liquor Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Liquor (Amendment) Regulations, 2017 and shall come into operation on the 1st October, 2017.

2. The Liquor Regulations are amended by substituting for the First Schedule, the following new Schedule —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Liquor (Amendment) Regulations, Citation  
2015.

2. The Liquor Regulations are amended at regulation 6 by substituting for Amendment of  
paragraph (a) of subregulation (2), the following new paragraph — regulation 6 of  
Cap. 43:11  
(Sub. Leg.)

“(a) play music within the licensed premises provided the music is not  
loud;”.
